



Operator Snapshot




The data contained in this dashboard explores concerns that operators of tourism related businesses have on Cape Breton Unama'ki. This dashboard contains data from two operator surveys and two surveys of students enrolled in the Bachelor of Hospitality and Tourism Management program at Cape Breton University (BHTM). The operator surveys represent the responses from over 60 operators of tourism related businesses across Cape Breton - Unama'ki. 




Reason for Employee Turnover









Workforce Issues Data

Data collected for this dashboard furthers our understanding of concerns and issues faced by tourism site operators on Cape Breton - Unama'ki. The data contained in this report was taken from several different sources. One source was an online operator survey sent to Cape Breton Island tourism operators in January and February of 2023. An additional operator survey was conducted in-person in August and September of 2023. The BHTM student survey was distributed initially between fall 2022 and winter 2023 and again in the fall of 2023.
